It's already nearly Christmas, time goes so fast. Here are some tips and great cultural activities to keep brushing up your French this summer. Enjoy!

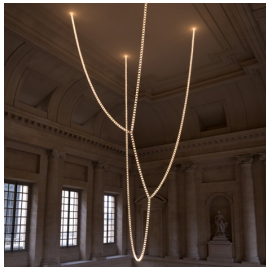
